

# Commercial Vendor RV Parking Terms and Conditions

San Mateo County Fair-Peninsula Festival, August 15 – 23, 2009

**All RVs must be parked only in the RV parking space to which they are assigned.**

1. A designated Fair employee must be present when you place your RV into your assigned space to ensure that it is correctly placed. If you park your RV on your own and you are parked in the wrong space, you will be required to move your RV to its correct space. There will be a Fair employee available to place RVs during the specific RV check-in times. RVs may be brought in during the following times:

<b>Tuesday, August 11th &amp; Wednesday, August 12th</b>	<b>8:00 AM - 5:00 PM</b>
<b>Thursday, August 13th</b>	<b>8:00 AM - 5:00 PM</b>
<b>Friday, August 14th</b>	<b>8:00 AM - 5:00 PM</b>

**\*RVs may not be brought in after 5:00 PM on Friday, August 14th 2009**

3. All Federal, State and Local Laws apply while you are participating in the San Mateo County Fair.
4. Individuals may not bring alcoholic beverages onto the San Mateo County Event Center grounds, including all parking lot areas.
5. All tow vehicles must be parked in a designated parking space with the parking pass
6. Any and all problems or situations that arise pertaining to RV parking should be brought to [Matt Cranford](#) immediately. [Fair Management](#), in conjunction with the Operations Department, will have the final authority pertaining to all RV parking issues.
7. **To meet Fire Marshal regulations, at no time may an extension cord be stretched across a road or fire lane to supply electricity to other RVs or stock trucks.** If cords are found Stretched Fair Management will unplug them and an attempt will be made to notify the owner of the vehicle to which the extension cord was connected. If this vehicle is found to be plugged in a second time, Fair Management reserves the right to confiscate the extension cord and/or require the owner to remove their RV or stock truck from the grounds. **No exceptions will be made to this rule.**
8. Fair Management reserves the right to remove any RV from the San Mateo County Event Center grounds if the vehicle's owner or occupants are found to be in violation of these terms and conditions, State and Local Fair Rules and Regulations, or Federal, State and Local laws while participating in the San Mateo County Fair.
