

**2022 Exhibitor Code of Conduct for
Participation in the San Mateo County Fair
Youth Livestock Competition**

As an animal exhibitor in the San Mateo County Fair Youth Livestock Program:

I believe my participation should demonstrate my own ability, knowledge, and skill as the owner of my show animal(s). I understand the need to be responsible in developing the skills necessary to take my animal from the farm to the show ring. I understand that no adult may assist in the washing, grooming, feeding, fitting, handling, and showing of my animal(s).

I have read and will follow the competition rules, and will not use abusive, questionable or unethical techniques in the feeding, caring, fitting, and showing of my animal(s). I understand this applies to my animal as well as to me.

I also agree to abide to the following:

- Obscene or discriminatory language or insubordination of any kind will NOT be tolerated.
- Alcohol, drugs, weapons of any kind and knives are not allowed on the fair grounds.
- Graffiti or destruction of any property is prohibited.

I have read and understand that all state and local rules apply. I have asked my parents and the supervisor/leader of my project not to break the rules or make exceptions on my behalf and to abide by this code of conduct. This code of conduct not only applies to my time at the fair, but for the length of my project.

I understand and agree that when I, my parent/guardian, my supervisor/leader or any other adult and/or minor connected with my project or animal(s) break the rules, Fair Management has the right to disqualify myself and/or my animal. In the event this happens, I will also be at risk of forfeiting any awards/premiums won and the right to show in the future at the San Mateo County Fair and/or any other California Fairs.

I accept that these entries are subject to the rules and regulations as published. I agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the fair, the county and the State of California from and against any liability, claim, loss or expense (including reasonable attorneys' fees) arising out of any injury or damage, which is caused by, arises from or is in any way connected with participation in the program or event, excepting only that caused by the sole active negligence of the Fair. The Fair Management shall not be responsible for accidents or losses that may occur to any of the exhibitors or exhibits at the Fair. The exhibitor (or parent or guardian of a minor) is responsible for any injury or damage resulting from the exhibitor's participation in the program or event. This includes any injury to others or to the exhibitor or to the exhibitor's property.
